



2018 COLUMBIA CORPORATE CHALLENGE

The Columbia Corporate Challenge is in its second year and will take place in the summer of 2018. The Columbia Corporate Challenge is designed to enable and promote company pride, community involvement, volunteerism and physical fitness through healthy competition. Six events will be offered that include both individual and team sports. All events will be held in conjunction with the existing Show-Me STATE GAMES activities.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Employees will form teams within their company for a one-time entry fee of **\$600**. The Corporate Challenge will run over two weekends, July 21-22 and July 28-29. Each company can enter one team or multiple teams. Companies can also partner with other companies to form one team. The schedule of events and number of participants allowed per sport is as follows*:

DIVISIONS

Divisions for small, medium, and large companies will be established once all companies have registered to participate in the Columbia Corporate Games with the goal of creating fair competition. If there is a limited number of companies participating, there will be one large division in which all teams compete.

POINT SYSTEM

Each sponsored event will contain a male & female category, each competing within the corporate challenge division. Co-Ed Softball and the Golf Team Scramble will have one category, which will go towards the team's total points. The first three male finishers and first three female finishers in the corporate challenge division will be awarded Show-Me State Games Medals, while **corporate challenge** points will be awarded to the top six finishers in each category, in each event.

VOLUNTEER POINTS

Companies will get additional points based on the number of their employees who volunteer for the Show-Me State Games. Each company will get 2 points for each team member who volunteers for the Show-Me State Games (to not exceed a maximum of 50 points or 25 volunteers). Additional information on volunteering will be distributed to team contact.

COMPANY AWARDS

After the completion of the Games, participants will be invited to a finale event which will consist of the presentation of the winning team for each division (Small, Medium and Large), as well as other potential awards.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Additional information for each event, as well as location and time updates, will be emailed out to each team's designated contact person prior to the first weekend of competition.
